

The international symposium on Nuclear Spectroscopy for Exotic Quantum System (NUSPEQ2023) will be held in Numazu, Shizuoka Japan, from March 7th to 9th, 2023. The symposium is jointly organized by CNS, University of Tokyo (Wako), RIKEN Nishina Center (Wako), JSPS Grant-in-aid for the scientific research for the innovative area, and JSPS-A3 Foresight program.

The scientific program will be devoted to the latest experimental and theoretical research and developments in nuclear reactions with exotic nuclei. The topics will include the following subjects relevant to the exotic nuclei:

- Fewbody system of nucleons
- Spectroscopy of exotic nuclei, such as drip-line and unbound nuclei
- Shell structure and its evolution
- Bulk properties and collective excitations
- Nuclear astrophysics
- Advances in direct reaction theory
- New instrumentation for direct reaction studies

The program of the symposium will consist of invited presentations. We will also have a poster session. We strongly encourage students and other junior researchers to participate.
